


Year 3 Topic Leaflet Autumn 2 Majestic Mountains









In this Geography-based topic, will be investigating majestic mountains. We will use maps to locate and find out about Mont Blanc, the Himalayas, Mount Everest, Ben Nevis and Badbury Rings. In English, we will be reading "Himalayan Mountains: Simon Chapman (Expedition Diaries)", where the Blue Peter Book Award winner brings geography to life in his recount of his journey along the Nujiang River, up through coniferous forests into the alpine region. Using this text as inspiration, we will be writing a newspaper report. We will also explore "Mountains of the World", which is a stunning non-fiction book, which examines the mountains that shape our world, from the peaks of the Himalayas to the Alps and the Andes. In Art, we will be creating a mountain collage using materials according to qualities, e.g. colour, texture, warmth to create more detailed artwork. In Design and Technology, we will design and make a Christmas decoration.
