The activity magazine 'Summer Adventures' will contain a range of activities, puzzles, recipes and ideas of things to do.

I am suggesting an age range of 8-13 years old but you know your child, younger children will still be able to use most of the parcel but may need some more help with some of the magazine activities, older children may find some of the magazine 'a bit young' but it depends on their mindset. I believe strongly in using recycled/recyclable materials and your packages will include no plastic packing and may come in reused envelopes.

**Both parcels cost £20 this includes posting**, the parcel will be addressed to your child.
